## Renovation Preparation Procedure

"Follow Order Exactly"

- 1- Spray for weeds if necessary. \* "Optional Procedure"  
(Do one week prior to onset of preparation.)
- 2- Mow all potential renovation area(s)...SHORT/SCALP!!!  
(Pickup clippings either by catcher or raking.)
- 3- Aerate (coring method, if possible) the area(s).
- 4- Dethatch (vertical-cut) the area(s); do in two directions perpendicular to the other direction. [This procedure is for removing any thatch layer and opening up turf area(s) for soil exposure.]
- 5- Rake-up all thatch and debris, and remove. It may be advantageous to mow one additional time after raking to level any long turf runners exposed by raking.
- 6- Place Top Soil (1/4" - 1/2" layer) over renovated area(s), along with enough Top Soil to fill-in and level (grade) any low-spots and/or undulations.
- 7- Hydrosod renovated turf area(s) with proper seed type.

\*Note: Placement of Top Soil can be skipped/bypassed for cost saving purposes, but is not recommended.
